COMMITTEE MINUTES JANUARY 14, 2016

Chairman Pepple called the meeting of the Ohio Criminal Justice Recodification Committee to order at approximately 1:00 pm.

The clerk called the roll and a quorum was present. Senator Eklund motioned to approve the December 3, 2015 minutes. The motion was seconded by Senator Obhof. The minutes were approved without objection.

The committee next began debate on the voting list distributed to the committee. The committee voted on the following questions:

Shall the workgroup's recommended statute combining 2909.05, 2909.06, and 2909.07 be forwarded to LSC for formal drafting? The vote passed 18-0.

Shall the workgroup's recommendations for Chapter 2909 be forwarded to LSC for formal drafting? The vote passed 18-0.

Shall the workgroup's proposed attempt language be removed from R.C. 2911.01(A) and R.C. 2911.02(A), prior to forwarding the draft to LSC for formal drafting? The vote failed on a 9-9 tie vote.

Shall the workgroup's proposed attempt language be removed from R.C. 2911.01(B), prior to forwarding the draft to LSC for formal drafting? The vote passed 15-4.

Shall the workgroup's recommendations (as amended) for Chapter 2911 be forwarded to LSC for formal drafting? The vote passed 19-0.

Shall the workgroup's recommendations for Chapter 2927 be forwarded to LSC for formal drafting? The vote passed 19-0.


After the voting had concluded, Sen. Thomas moved for unanimous consent to change his vote from "no" to "yes" on the question of "Shall the workgroup's proposed attempt language be removed from R.C. 2911.01(A) and R.C. 2911.02(A), prior to forwarding the draft to LSC for formal drafting?" Sen. Thomas indicated he had voted in error and had intended to vote "yes." Members of the committee objected to the request and the motion failed.

After finishing with the vote, the following workgroups presented and discussed their drafts and took questions from the committee:

- 2901/2903 General Provision and Assault and Homicide
- 2913 Theft
- 2923 Weapon Control, Corrupt Activity, and Gangs

The committee announced that the March meeting had officially been moved to March 24, 2016.

With no further business to come before the Committee, Chairman Peple adjourned the meeting at approximately 4:55 p.m.
